

# The Site

Green & Away's aim is to share Green issues by enabling visitors to experience sustainable living and working in practice. The Resurgence conference is one of a series we run on a small organic farm in beautiful rolling countryside. The site is designed to be a showcase of low impact technologies, with electricity from the wind and sun, solar and wood-burning showers, meeting spaces made of coppiced hazel and recycled canvas, art and craft activities and composting toilets,

The fees include all main meals, mostly organic, local or fair-traded, with some fruit, salad and vegetables from our own garden. The food is all vegetarian, with vegan options and we can cater for most special diets if given notice. Some of our milk comes from the cows in the neighbouring fields. We run a bar with local real ales, farmhouse cider and organic wines. Our snack bar is stocked with mouth-watering snacks that are organic and fair-traded.

The camp is built around a traditional village green where all activities take place. There is an atmosphere of close community making the event genial whether you come alone or with friends and family. We do need all of you to participate in the running of the camp. Your involvement is needed in cutting firewood, cooking and washing up, (we don't use any disposable plates or cutlery.) These shared activities are fun and enjoyable.

## What to Bring

You need to bring your own bedding, tent, torch, rainwear and environmentally-friendly soaps and shampoos, so we can keep the land unpolluted. We have a small number of tents, yurts and domes available for hire. If demand is heavy we give priority to people coming by public transport and we may ask you to share. Do bring along your musical instruments if you are a musician.

### Some Don'ts

The marvellous atmosphere we work to create is also based, we're afraid, on a few don'ts. So we will welcome you warmly, but please don't bring your dogs, your computer games or radios. We ask you not to smoke where the activities take place and not to bring your car further than the site entrance; we have a wonderful selection of barrows for you to move tents and luggage.

### Transport

The camp is accessible by public transport with buses from Gloucester rail and bus station to a bus stop two miles from the site and we meet your bus with a vehicle. With your payment receipt, we will send you detailed travel directions including bus times, maps and descriptions of the route for cyclists, motorists and hitch hikers. We also run a lift exchange service for those attending - please do fill in this part of the booking form.
